Chart 1 **Number of Employed Persons in the Accommodation and Food Service Activities Industry by Gender 2003-2018**

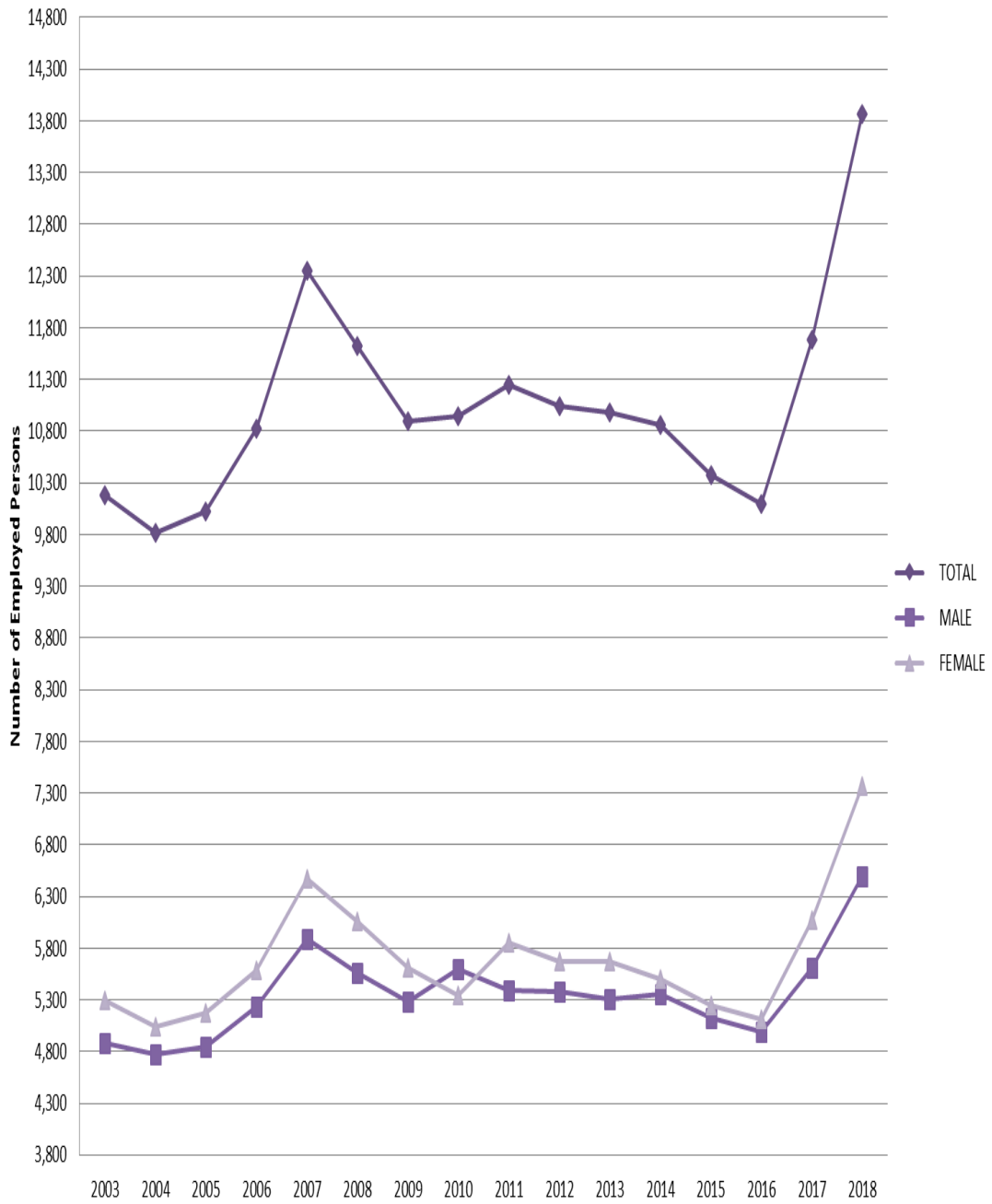

Trend of Average Weekly Wage by Gender 2003-2018

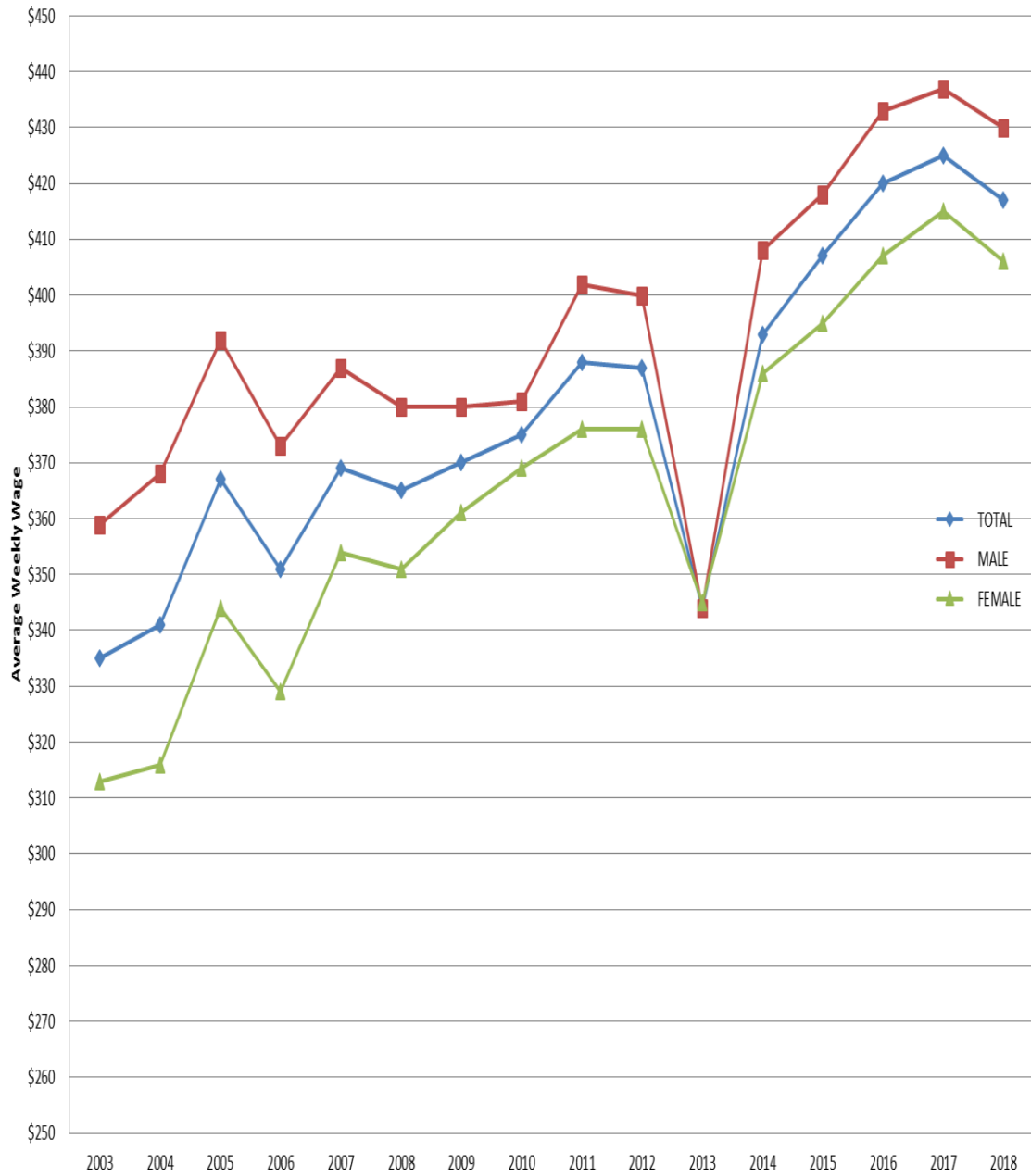
